The LACOE Induction Program is a state-approved Induction Program for eligible teachers who need to complete teacher induction for the Professional Clear Credential



Program Description

- ☞ Research-based and designed especially for newly credentialed teachers
- ☞ Job-embedded induction program meets CTC induction requirements
- ☞ Two-year, developmentally sequenced, program of support for California teachers holding a Preliminary/Level 1 Education Specialist, Multiple Subject, or Single Subject credential, based on California state induction standards
- ☞ The Early Completion Option is available for participants who meet eligibility requirements

Program Requirements

- ☞ Weekly meetings with an assigned support provider/mentor, including teacher observations
- ☞ Develop and implement an Individual Learning Plan that is in alignment with local goals and expectations
- ☞ Attend two *Teacher Learning Communities* per year
- ☞ Self-select and reflect on three professional development activities related to the Individual Learning Plan
- ☞ Submit Evidence of Teacher Practice in the form of documented mentor conversations and written reflections in an electronic portfolio
